

The Vignamato winery is a 9 hectares estate located in San Paolo di Jesi (le Marche Region), in a territory boasting a thousand-year tradition of vine-growing and wine-producing.

The business was founded at the end of the 1950s, by enthusiastic vine-dressers Amato Ceci and wife Maria, who started up the production and marketing of the wine. Their experience and enthusiasm have led their son, Maurizio, assisted by his wife, Serenella, to continue in his parents' footsteps and to start a careful selection of all the company's products.

The vinification of the white wine combines tradition with modern production technology in order to best exalt the characteristics of the Verdicchio, whilst the red wine is vinified following traditional methods.

The family has always distinguished itself for its determination in producing quality wines, with an excellent price-quality ratio.

Valle delle Lame

Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico DOC (of controlled origin)

Made from a selection of grapes from a vineyard adjacent to Via Valle delle Lame in the commune of San Paolo di Jesi.

The ground is of average consistency, dominated by clay.

The wine is vinified, undergoes gentle pressing, static decantation and fermentation at controlled temperatures, with carefully chosen yeasts, and rests briefly on the lees.



Appearance: straw yellow with greenish hues.
Aroma: delicate aroma, hints of fruit and flowers.
Flavour: dry, full-bodied, sapid, fresh, with a slightly bitter aftertaste.
Food accompaniments: starters, fish pasta and rice dishes, white meats, or excellent served as an aperitif.
Serving temperature: 10-12°C
